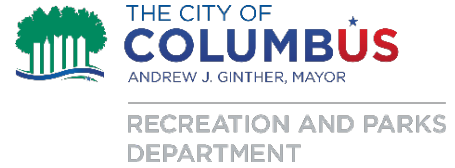


COLUMBUS RECREATION AND PARKS
